## **DAILY ORDER**

1. The present matter alongwith IAs were kept for hearing on 13.01.2026.
2. During the hearing, the representative, appearing on behalf of the Respondent GUVNL, submitted that the Applicant/Petitioner Distributed Solar Power Association (DSPA) has filed the present Petition seeking issuance of the tariff order providing the regulatory framework for Wind-Solar Hybrid Projects in Gujarat for the period post 20.06.2023, i.e. the GERC Wind Solar Hybrid Tariff Order, 2023. She further submitted that during the pendency of the present Petition, the Commission issued the Wind Solar Hybrid Tariff Order No. 01 of 2024 on 22.02.2024 providing the tariff framework for Procurement of Power by Distribution licensees and Others from Wind Solar Hybrid Projects including storage, if any, and other commercial issues for State of Gujarat. She submitted that the Order providing for the tariff framework for Wind Solar Hybrid Projects has already been issued by the Commission vide Wind Solar Hybrid Tariff Order No. 01 of 2024 on 22.02.2024 and therefore, the present Petition & IAs becomes infructuous. However, the Commission may consider to provide an opportunity to the Applicant/Petitioner DSPA & the Applicant IWEA to make submissions, in the matter.
3. Heard the Respondent. We note that when the matter was called out, nobody was present on behalf of the Applicant/Petitioner DSPA, Applicant IWEA and Respondents No. 2 & 3 although the hearing notice was issued to them. We note the submissions of the Respondent GUVNL that the Commission has already issued tariff framework for Wind Solar Hybrid Project and as such the present Petition becomes infructuous. However, in the interest of Justices, the matter stands adjourned on

account of non-appearance of the Applicant/Petitioner DSPA and Applicant IWEA, so as to provide one last opportunity of hearing to the Applicant/Petitioner prior to deciding the present matter. Accordingly, we direct the Applicant/Petitioner DSPA and Applicant IWEA to remain present during the next date of hearing. We also make it clear that if the Applicant/Petitioner DSPA and Applicant IWEA does not remain present during the next date of hearing, the Commission will decide the matter based on the records of the present Petition and no further adjournment shall be granted.

4. Next date of hearing will be intimated separately.
5. Order accordingly.
