**Record of Proceedings**

The matter was heard through a virtual hearing.

2. The Petitioner's representative submitted that the amended Petition was filed vide affidavit dated 17.12.2025, in light of the observations in the Commission's order dated 23.7.2025 in Petition No. 216/TT.2020 (remanded matter). He sought two weeks' time to furnish the information sought in the last Record of Proceedings dated 16.12.2025.

3. The learned counsel for the Uttar Pradesh Power Corporation Limited (UPPCL) requested the Commission to allow two weeks' time to file its reply in the matter.

4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Respondents to file their respective replies to the amended Petition within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within one week thereafter.



5. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit the information sought vide its RoP dated 16.12.2025, in the form of an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks.

6. The Petition will be listed for hearing on **16.4.2026**.
