- Subject : Petition for truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period for 220 kV Srinagar-Baramwari line [Point of Inter-connection (of Singoli-Bhatwari HEP from the proposed Baramwari-Srinagar 220 kV D/C line) to Khandukhal (Srinagar) Sub-station] under UITP Scheme (deemed ISTS) as per the Commission's order dated 31.1.2013 in Petition No. 133/MP/2012 in the Northern Region.

Record of Proceedings

The matter was heard through a virtual hearing.

2. During the hearing, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted as under:
 - a) Since the forest clearance and land compensation expenses were inadvertently considered in IEDC, the Petitioner has revised the submissions and submitted the revised Auditor's Certificate and Forms.
 - b) As per the Commission's direction vide order dated 20.1.2024 in Petition No. 478/TT/2020, the Petitioner has submitted the re-apportionment of the capital cost between the transmission asset and the cost of the balance work on a pro-rata basis.
3. The learned counsel for the Petitioner has prayed to consider the revised Auditor's Certificate and the revised tariff forms and allow the transmission tariff accordingly.
4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Respondents, as a last opportunity, to file their respective replies, if any, within two (2) weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within one (1) week, thereafter.



5. The Petitioner is directed to submit the following information on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two (2) weeks:
- a. Reconcile the Liability Flow Statement with the ACE claimed for the 2019-24 tariff period.
 - b. PFC loan document, indicating the interest rates applied in the IDC calculation statement submitted by the Petitioner.
6. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the order in the matter.
