**Record of Proceedings**

The matter was heard through a virtual hearing.

2. During the course of the hearing, the representative(s) of the Petitioner submitted that these Petitions have been filed for truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and/or the determination of transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period and further sought liberty to file an amended Petition incorporating the reconductoring work within four weeks.
3. Respondent No. 1, i.e., TANGEDCO, sought liberty to file its reply in the matter.
4. After hearing, the Commission directed as under:
  - (a) The Respondent(s), including TANGEDCO, to file their replies, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week thereafter.



(b) The Petitioner is directed to file an amended Petition incorporating the reconductoring work within four weeks and to furnish the following information on an affidavit, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Respondent(s):

(i) The OEM Certificate with respect to the ACE claimed under Regulation 25(2) of the 2024 Tariff Regulations;

(ii) A reconciled Form-6, as the values do not match those reflected in the Auditor's Certificate;

(iii) Complete details of the LoA for the reconductoring works;

(iv) The Petitioner has filed two sets of tariff forms for the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff periods. However, the new equipment covered in the instant Petition does not constitute new assets; rather, it pertains to reconductoring and upgradation of existing transmission assets, and is claimed as Add-Cap. Therefore, the Petitioner shall file a single set of tariff forms in the amended Petition with respect to the transmission assets for the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff period.

5. The matter will be listed for further hearing on **16.4.2026**.
