### **Record of Proceedings**

The matters were called out for a virtual hearing.

2. During the course of the hearing, the representative(s) of the Petitioner submitted that these Petitions have been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period.

3. In Petition No. 561/TT/2025, the Petitioner sought two weeks' time to file rejoinder to the reply of Respondent No. 16, PTCUL.

4. The learned counsel for Respondent No. 1, i.e., TNPDCCL, sought ten days' time to file reply in Petition No. 918/TT/2025.

5. After hearing the parties, the Commission directed as under:

- i) **Petition No. 561/TT/2025**: The Petitioner is directed to file rejoinder to the reply of PTCUL within two weeks and all other Respondent(s) to file their respective replies, if any, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week, thereafter.
- ii) **Petition No. 918/TT/2025** : The Respondents, including TANGEDCO, to file their reply within ten days with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week, thereafter.
- iii) In other Petitions, the Respondent(s) to file their respective replies, if any, within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week, thereafter.
- iv) The Petitioner is directed to furnish the following information, on an affidavit, within two weeks with an advance copy to the Respondents:

- a) Cumulative depreciation for IT and PLCC up to 31.3.2019.

### **Petition No. 561/TT/2025**



- a) Form-5 and Form-13;
- b) Form-7B;
- c) Detailed justification for the variation in element-wise capital cost as claimed in the instant Petition vis-à-vis the capital cost allowed by the Commission vide order dated 31.3.2021 in Petition No. 104/TT/2020.
- d) The Petitioner has submitted that the down-stream network associated with Asset-III, owned by PTCUL, is yet to be commissioned. Clarify as to how the Asset-III is combined with the other assets for claiming the AFC in the instant Petition;
- e) Status of the down-stream network associated with Asset-III under the scope of PTCUL.

- a) Form-9C with respect to both new and existing assets for the 2019-24 & 2024-29 tariff period in excel format with proper linkages;
- b) The details of the Additional Capital Expenditure (ACE) claimed with respect to the replacement of equipment, in a following format:

**Petition No. 950/TT/2025**

- a) OEM Certificate with respect to the sub-station equipment proposed to be replaced during the 2019-24 tariff period, as directed by the Commission vide order dated 22.1.2022 in Petition No. 325/TT/2020.
