Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the representative of the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner and CTUIL have filed their respective affidavits furnishing the information called for *vide* Record of Proceedings dated 21.1.2026.

2. Considering the above, the Commission directed the Respondent, CTUIL, to file the following information/clarification, on an affidavit, within a week:

- (a) Copy of CTUIL OM vide which it has communicated to TSP for implementation of instant scheme under RTM with an estimated cost of Rs. 83.06 crore.
- (b) When the cost of ATS was revised to Rs. 105.09 crore, and the same was approved in the 31st NCT dated 14.07.2025, whether the revised cost of ATS was taken from the connectivity grantee?
- (c) Comments on the variation in the estimated cost of the Project as per the Petitioner (Rs. 144.89 crore) vis-à-vis the estimated cost approved by NCT (Rs. 105.09 crore)

(d) How does an instant transmission system ensure optimal utilisation of existing network infrastructure when there is already a margin of about 1500 MW available at the 400 kV level?

3. The Petition will be listed for hearing on **18.3.2026**.
