Record of Proceedings

The matter was heard through a virtual hearing.

2. At the outset, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that in accordance with the Commission's order dated 13.6.2021 in Petition No. 81/TT/2016, the Petitioner has provided justifications for the delay due to forest clearance and other RoW issues. He further submitted that the entire capital expenditure claimed from the date of commercial operation (COD), including Additional Capital Expenditure (ACE), is supported by the Auditor's certificate and the same may be considered.
3. None of the Respondents has filed their replies despite notice in the matter.
4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within four weeks:



- i. Justification for claiming the expenditure of ₹180.35 lakh against PMO ADB as ACE for the 2014-19 tariff period.
- ii. Liability Flow Statement for the 2014-19 and 2019-24 tariff periods.

5. The Commission further directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within two weeks thereafter.

6. The Petition will be listed for hearing on **16.4.2026**.
