**Record of Proceedings**

The matters were heard through a virtual hearing.

2. The learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the instant matters have been remanded by the APTEL vide judgment dated 14.7.2025 in Appeal Nos. 226 of 2020 and 146 of 2021, preferred against the Commission's orders dated 21.6.2018 in Petition No. 241/TT/2016 and 22.6.2018 in Petition No. 6/TT/2018, respectively. The



APTEL vide its judgment dated 14.7.2025 has directed the Commission to consider the capitalisation of the Initial Spares at 6% under the “*Brown Field Transmission Substation Asset*”. He further submitted that the revised tariff forms with respect to the 2014-19, 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff periods have been filed vide affidavit dated 20.11.2025 in Petition No. 576/TT/2025 (i.e., Petition for true-up of tariff for the 2019-24 period and determination of tariff for the 2024-29 period with respect to the same transmission assets) in terms of the APTEL’s judgment and the order in the Petition was reserved on 11.12.2025.

3. The learned counsel for BRPL sought time to file its reply/written submissions for all the tariff periods in Petition No. 576/TT/2025.

4. The Commission acceded to the request of BRPL and directed BRPL to file its reply/written submissions within two (2) weeks in Petition No. 576/TT/2025, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder/written submissions, if any, within a week thereafter.

5. The Commission further observed that since the Petitioner has filed the revised tariff forms with respect to 2014-19, 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff periods in Petition No. 576/TT/2025 which stands reserved, the revised consequential transmission tariff in terms of the APTEL’s judgment dated 14.7.2025 for the 2014-19 tariff period shall be considered in Petition No. 576/TT/2025 alongwith the truing-up of the tariff for the 2019-24 period and the determination of the tariff for the 2024-29 period.

6. Accordingly, Petition Nos. 241/TT/2016 and 6/TT/2018 stand disposed of.
