Record of Proceedings

The representative of the Petitioners submitted that the amended memo of parties has already been filed vide affidavit dated 02.03.2026, and the Petitioners have complied with all requirements, including publication of notices under the provisions of the Transmission Licence Regulations. The representative further submitted that replies have been filed to the comments/objections received in response to the publication of the notice. The representative, accordingly, prayed for the grant of a transmission licence.

2. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the Petitioners, the Commission directed the Petitioner to follow the procedure as prescribed under the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Procedure, Terms and Conditions for



Grant of Transmission License and other related matters) Regulations, 2024, for informing the parties to the Petition. The applicant for the transmission licence is co-Petitioner (KPS III HVDC Transmission Limited); accordingly, the Commission granted two weeks' time to the co-Petitioner to serve notice upon the respondents, who may file their respective response, if any, within a week thereafter.

3. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the order in the matters.
