Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner has complied with the directions issued vide Record of Proceedings dated 24.2.2026 by way of an affidavit dated 10.3.2026. She submitted that out of the total awarded capacity of 1500 MW, the Petitioner has already executed the Power Supply Agreements (PSAs) for 1150 MW – 450 MW with Bihar Discoms and 700 MW with TNPDC, which have been placed on record. She further submitted that the remaining 350 MW had not yet been tied up, and any additional PSAs executed subsequently will be placed on record.

2. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the following information/clarification, on an affidavit, within two weeks:

- (a) The reasons for the delay in approaching the Commission as per Clause 11.4 of the Guidelines dated 9.6.2023.
- (b) The updated status of allocation for the remaining 350 MW capacity.



3. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the matter for order.
