Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner has duly complied with the directions issued *vide* Record of Proceedings for the hearing dated 21.1.2026 and has also placed on record the details regarding the competitiveness of the discovered tariff *vide* affidavit dated 4.2.2026. The learned counsel further submitted that, out of the total 1500 MW capacity, the Petitioner has obtained consent from various DISCOMs and has entered into a Power Sale Agreement (PSA) with Bihar on 12.2.2026.

2. In response to a specific query of the Commission regarding the quantum of capacity tied up, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that 450 MW out of the total 1500 MW capacity has been tied up under an executed PSA. In respect of the balance capacity, it was submitted that discussions are at an advanced stage with DISCOMs of Tamil Nadu, Kerala, and other States.

3. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission directed the parties to submit the following information, on an affidavit, within two weeks:

(a) Bid Evaluation Committee to submit the certification to the effect that the discovered tariff is reasonable and;

(b) The Petitioner to submit the copies of the PSAs signed with the concerned Discoms.

4. The matter will be listed for the hearing on **9.3.2026**.
