Record of Proceedings

The matters were called out for a virtual hearing.

2. During the course of the hearing, the representative(s) of the Petitioner submitted that these Petitions have been filed for the determination-cum-truing up and/or truing up of the



transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period.

3. In Petition No. 389/TT/2024, the Petitioner sought 3 weeks' time to file the reply to the technical validation letter dated 6.2.2026.
4. In Petition No. 743/TT/2024, the Petitioner sought 4 weeks' time to file additional information.
5. In Petition No. 766/TT/2025, the Respondent, i.e., MPPMCL, sought 2 weeks' time to file reply in the Petition.
6. After hearing, the Commission directed as under:
 - i. **In Petition No. 380/TT/2024**: issue notice to the Respondent(s). The Respondent(s) including MPPMCL to file their respective replies, if any, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week, thereafter;
 - ii. In all other Petitions, the Respondent(s) to file their respective replies, if any, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder/written submission, if any, within a week, thereafter;
 - iii. **In Petition No. 398/TT/2024**: CTUIL is directed to clarify whether the implementation time frame with respect to the augmentation of transformation capacity by 1x500 MVA, 400/220 kV ICT (6th ICT), awarded to the Petitioner vide OM dated 24.6.2022 and subsequently amended vide OM dated 25.8.2022 and 7.8.2023, has been revised or not. If revised, CTUIL shall provide the revised implementation time frame with respect to the instant transmission asset.
 - iv. The Petitioner, is directed to furnish the following information, on an affidavit, within two weeks with an advance copy to the Respondents with respect to under-mentioned Petitions:

- a) Form-9C in excel format;
- b) Form-5 and Form-7B;
- c) Details of rate of interest for IDC considered in the IDC Statement;
- d) IDC Statement in a linked excel with interest rates for all sources of financing;
- e) Status of Re-conductoring work, whether completed or not. If completed, provide the date of completion of work along with de-capitalisation details in respect of re-conductoring work. Also, submit the supporting documents in respect of actual ACE claimed by the Petitioner during 2019-24 Tariff Period against re-conductoring works.
- f) Whether, the 765 kV 1500 MVA ICT (3rd) at Bikaner (PG) is associated with any RE generator. If so, provide the detail of connectivity granted to said generator

- a) COD and NRLDC Certificate for Asset-12;
- b) Form-9C in a excel format along with proper linkages for both the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff period;
- c) Detailed calculations of the interest rates considered for each loan in Form-9C for both the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff period;
- d) Revised Cost Estimate (RCE) for the assets in the instant Petition, as there is a cost overrun with respect to the FR apportioned cost during the 2024-29 tariff period.
- e) IDC Statements for all the assets covered in the instant Petition.
- f) IDC and Notional IDC sheets in a excel format.
- g) Form-7B.
- h) Form-12 with respect to the instant assets as per the given format mentioned below:

- i) The Petitioner has claimed a time overrun with respect to the transmission assets covered in the Petition and has submitted the justification/reasons collectively. Provide a detailed reason-wise bifurcation of the time overrun claimed on account of denial of PTW, work permits, RoW issues, rain, heavy fog during winter and COVID-19 with respect to the transmission assets covered in the Petition, along with supporting documents.

- a) Reconciliation of Plant and Machinery Cost as per Form-5 and Form-13.
- b) Details of the rate of interest considered for IDC in the IDC Statement;
- c) Reasons for claiming the SCOD with respect to the Augmentation of Transformation Capacity by 1x500 MVA, 400/220 kV ICT (6th ICT) as on 7.2.2024, in accordance with the CTUIL's OM dated 7.8.2023.

Petition No. 743/TT/2025

- a) Single consolidated set of tariff forms for both the 2019–24 and 2024–29 tariff periods, as the claimed works pertain only to reconductoring and upgradation of the existing transmission assets under Additional Capitalization and not for new assets;
- b) Documentary evidence with respect to the RoW compensation claimed during the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff period;



- c) Clarify the status of the reconductoring work, whether it has been completed or not. If completed, provide the date of completion along with details of de-capitalisation with respect to the reconductoring work. Further, furnish the supporting documents with respect to the actual ACE claimed by the Petitioner during the 2019-24 tariff period against the reconductoring works.
