Record of Proceedings

The matters were called out for a virtual hearing.



2. During the course of the hearing, the representative(s) of the Petitioner submitted that these Petitions have been filed for the determination-cum-truing up and truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period.
3. In Petition No. 391/TT/2024, the Petitioner sought time to file rejoinder to the reply of Respondent No. 1, TANGEDCO [now TNPDC].
4. After hearing, the Commission directed as under:
 - i. **In Petition No. 391/TT/2024**: The Petitioner to file rejoinder to the reply of TNPDC within a week and all other Respondent(s) to file their respective replies, if any, within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week, thereafter.
 - ii. **In Petition No. 454/TT/2024**: CTUIL to furnish the following information on an affidavit within a week:
 - a) The start date of connectivity and SCOD of RE generation;
 - b) Whether there is any mismatch between the transmission system implemented by the Petitioner and RE generation under the control of NTPC.
 - iii. The Respondent(s) to file their respective replies, if any, within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week, thereafter.
5. The Petitioner is directed to furnish the following information, on an affidavit, within a week with an advance copy to the Respondent(s):

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- a) The estimated completion cost in comparison with the awarded cost as per the LoA;
- b) Whether the Petitioner has recovered any LD from contractor? If so, submit the details thereof.

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- a) Form-9C in excel format;
- b) Form-5 and Form-7B;
- c) Details of the rate of interest considered for IDC in the IDC statement;
- d) IDC Statement showing the total IDC amount in excel format along with the interest rates for all sources of financing;
- e) The estimated completion cost in comparison with the awarded cost as per the LoA;
- f) Whether the Petitioner has recovered any LD from contractor? If so, submit the details thereof.



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- a) Form-5 and Form 7B;
- b) Details of the rate of interest considered for IDC in the IDC statement;
- c) The estimated completion cost in comparison with the awarded cost as per the LoA;
- d) Whether the Petitioner has recovered any LD from contractor? If so, submit the details thereof.

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- a) Form 7B;
- b) Details of the rate of interest considered for IDC in the IDC Statement.

5. Subject to above, the Commission reserved the above matters for order.
