### **Record of Proceedings**

The Petitioners' representatives submitted that these Petitions have been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 period.

2. The Petitioner's representative submitted that the final judgment in the Appeal being DFR No. 104/2025 filed before the APTEL is pending in Petition No. 822/TT/2025.
3. The representative for Respondent No. 1, i.e., Madhya Pradesh Power Management Company Limited (MPPMCL), sought time to file reply in Petition No. 750/TT/2025.
4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, within one week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within one week thereafter.
5. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:

- (v) Item-wise details of the ACE incurred during the 2019-24 tariff period and projected during the 2024-29 tariff period.
