Record of Proceedings

The matter was heard through a virtual hearing.

2. During the hearing, the representative(s) of the Petitioner submitted that the pleadings have been completed, and requested that the submissions be considered while allowing the transmission tariff for the said tariff period.
3. None appeared on behalf of the Respondent(s) in the instant Petition despite notice.
4. After hearing the representative(s) of the Petitioner, the Commission directed the Respondent(s) to file their replies, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week thereafter.
5. The Petitioner is directed to furnish the following information on an affidavit, within a week, with an advance copy to the Respondent(s):
 - a) RCE-II with respect to Asset-II;



- b) A comparison of the RCE and the approved cost after revising the Notional IDC claimed vide affidavit dated 19.1.2026, along with justification;
 - c) As per the Form-12 submitted vide affidavit dated 19.1.2026, there is a delay of 3-4 months in the start dates of Letter of Award (LoA), Supply and Erection as compared to the schedule dates, along with justification.
6. The matter will be listed for further hearing on **16.4.2026**.
