Record of Proceedings

These matters were heard through a virtual hearing.

2. The Petitioner’s representatives submitted that these Petitions have been filed for truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period. He further submitted that the Petitioner has filed the information sought by the Commission in both the Petitions. He also submitted that none of the Respondents have filed reply in these matters.

3. In Petition No. 529/TT/2025, the representative of the Petitioner submitted that the Petitioner has filed the amended Petition on account of the reconductoring works (including associated bay modification works) of the assets in the Chukha



Transmission System. He further submitted that since certain latest development has taken place in the course of reconductoring, the Petitioner may be granted time to file the additional information regarding the reconductoring..

4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within one week thereafter.

5. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:

- (i) Details of the ACE claimed on account of the Infrastructure development as claimed in the Petition.

In Petition No. 744/TT/2025

- (i) Regulations under which the ACE has been claimed in respective tariff periods and also provide the detailed justifications for the same.
- (ii) Liability Flow Statement in excel format in reconciliation with the ACE claimed as per the Petition.
