Minutes of 16th Meeting with RE developers and their Associations held on 12-12-2025

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of COO, CTUIL among CTU, RE developers and their associations on 12-12-2025 at CTUIL office, Gurgaon. List of participants enclosed at **Annex-I**. The issues raised by the developers and deliberation held on the same are under:

1. Processing of applications prior to 3rd amendment of GNA (effective date-09.09.2025) regulations

Members requested CTUIL to process all connectivity applications submitted prior to 3rd amendment of GNA (effective date-09.09.2025) as per the then-applicable regulations on a first-come-first-serve basis.

CTUIL response: CTU stated that the matter is under examination and priority will not be affected. However, application is to be processed considering the amended Regulations only, read in conjunction with transitions clauses in the amendment.

2. Land requirement for BESS

Members requested CTUIL to formally notify the land requirement for BESS to bring regulatory clarity.

CTUIL response: It was informed that land requirement of 3 Acre/100 MWh has already been informed during stakeholder consultation. The same shall be formally notified in the detailed procedure under GNA regulations.

3. Regulation 37.10(b) of GNA Regulations – Conn-BG-2 requirement

Members raised concerns regarding the applicability of Regulation 37.10(b), particularly for projects granted connectivity prior to the Third Amendment and sharing a terminal bay.

CTUIL response: CTU informed that reg 8.2 shall be read with reg 5.6 and 5.7, and hence it clarifies that all the applicants have to submit the CON BG2.

4. Flexibility and clarification on change of source under Regulation 9.3, including applicability beyond the 18-month window and for additional capacity added under Regulations 5.2/5.11.

CTUIL response: CTUIL shall take up a dedicated session for the same with developers.

5. The ROFR period has been extended by Hon'ble CERC by 75 days and waiting for its completion would delay grant of drawal permission for BESS, especially since several developers have already placed BESS orders.

CTUIL response: Member requested CTUIL to expedite system studies and issue drawal permissions based on application priority, which CTUIL accepted.

6. Member requested that Regulations 15.2 and 15.3 (transfer and splitting of connectivity) be made applicable to RPPDs, in line with Regulation 15.1 read with Regulation 11A(5), which permits intra-group utilisation of connectivity and execution through SPVs.

CTUIL response: CERC GNA Regulations, 2022 does not have provision regarding the transfer & splitting of connectivity to RPPDs.
