- Subject : Petition under Section 79(1)(c) 79 (1) (h) of the Electricity Act, 2003 read with Regulation 15 of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Conduct of Business) Regulation, 1999, Regulation 42 and 44 of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Connectivity and General Network Access to the Inter-State Transmission System) Regulations, 2022 and Regulation 57 and 58 of the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Indian Electricity Grid Code), Regulation, 2023 seeking relaxation of Regulation 22 (3) (c) of the Indian Electricity Grid Code, 2023 for permitting commissioning of Wind Turbine Generators (WTGs) in Tranches of at least 5 MW for the Petitioner's Wind Power Project

Record of Proceedings

The learned counsel for the Petitioner, CPTPL, submitted that the present Petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking relaxation of Regulation 22(3)(c) of IEGC, 2023 for permitting the Petitioner to commissioning its 36 MW Wind Power Project in a phased manner, in tranches of not less than 5 MW per phase, as and when such capacity becomes technically ready for the commissioning. The learned counsel further submitted that under the extant framework, the benefit of waiver of ISTS charges on transmission of electricity generated from solar and wind sources of energy has been extended only till 30th June 2026; hence, the matter may be listed on any short date, preferably in May 2026 itself.

2. After considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission ordered as under:

- (a) Admit and issue notice to the Respondent, subject to just exceptions;



(b) The Respondent to file its reply, if any, within three weeks, with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder within two weeks thereafter.

3. The Petition will be listed for the hearing on **26.5.2026**.
