Record of Proceedings

The learned counsel for the Petitioner, MISTL, submitted that the present Petitions had been filed for the grant of a transmission licence to establish the inter-state transmission project i.e., "Transmission System for Evacuation of Power from RE Projects in Morena SEZ in Madhya Pradesh-Phase I (2500 MW)" ('the Project') and for the adoption of the transmission charges in respect of the Project discovered pursuant to the tariff based competitive bidding process.

2. After hearing the learned counsel for the Petitioner, the Commission directed as under:

- a. The Petitioner to implead all beneficiaries of the Western Region, along with M/s Apraava Energy Pvt. Ltd. and MPPTCL, as party Respondents and file an amended memo of parties within three days.
 - b. Admit and issue notice to all the Respondents, including the impleaded Respondents;
 - c. The Respondents, to file their respective replies, if any, within a week with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder(s) within a week thereafter.
 - d. The Petitioner to file its compliance affidavit in terms of Regulations 5(8) and 5(10) of the 2024 Transmission Licence Regulations within a week and the BPC the complete information along with the certificate confirming the Annual Transmission Charges.
3. The Petitions will be listed for hearing on **24.4.2026**.
