The representative of the Petitioner, BDPTL, submitted that the present Petitions had been filed for the grant of a transmission licence to establish the Inter-State Transmission system for "Transmission system strengthening for integration of additional RE potential at Davanagere (0.25 GW) and Bellary (2.75 GW)" ('the Project') and for the adoption of the transmission charges in respect of the Project discovered pursuant to the tariff based competitive bidding process.
