Record of Proceedings

The matter was heard through video conferencing.

2. The Petitioner has filed this Petition for true-up of the tariff for nine transmission assets owned by it, which transmit electricity to other States for the 2019-24 tariff period, as well as for the determination of the tariff for the 2024-29 period.
3. The learned counsel for Respondent No. 5, i.e., Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Limited (KPTCL) sought four weeks' time to file the reply to the Petition.
4. After the hearing, the Commission directed as under:
 - a) Issue notice to the Respondents;



- b) The Respondents to file their respective replies, if any, within four weeks, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within two weeks thereafter.
5. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within three week:
- i. Liability Flow Statement for the 2019-24 tariff period;
 - ii. Supporting documents against the actual Additional Capital Expenditure (ACE) claimed in respect of Assets IV, V and VII for the 2019-24 tariff period; and
 - iii. Copy of Form-7.
6. The Petition will be listed for hearing on **14.5.2026**.
