Record of Proceedings

These matters were heard through a virtual hearing.

2. The instant Petitions have been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 tariff period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 tariff period.
3. The Petitioners' representatives in the captioned matters submitted that the Petitioner has already furnished all the information sought by the Commission and urged the Commission to reserve orders in these cases.
4. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with an advance copy to the Respondents within two weeks:

In Petition No. 412/TT/2025

- i. Item-wise details of the ACE claimed for the 2019-24 tariff period and the projected ACE for the 2024-29 tariff period, as there is a significant difference between the approved and claimed figures.
- ii. Equipment-wise cost estimate for the ACE projected for the 2024-29 tariff period.
- iii. Justification and supporting documents for the contingency liability claim of Rs. 8752.92 lakh in the present Petition.

In Petition No. 578/TT/2025

- i. Equipment-wise cost estimates for the Additional Capital Expenditure (ACE) claimed for the 2019-24 tariff period and projected for the 2024-29 tariff period.

In Petition No. 599/TT/2025

- i. The Interest During Construction (IDC) sheets in Excel format for all the assets.



5. The Commission also directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if not already filed, within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week thereafter.

6. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the orders in these matters.
