Record of Proceedings

These Petitions have been filed for the truing up of the transmission tariff for the 2019-24 period and the determination of the transmission tariff for the 2024-29 period. During the course of the hearing, the Petitioner's representatives briefed about the Petitions and requested that the transmission tariff be allowed as claimed in these Petitions.

2. After the hearing, the Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the following information, on an affidavit, with a copy to the Respondents, within two weeks:

In Petition No. 479/TT/2025

- i. Provision under which the cost of OPGW is shared at the rate of 50%, along with supporting documents, in compliance with the Commission's directions vide order dated 26.5.2022 in Petition No. 352/TT/2020.
- ii. Specify the details of the total number of fibres. Indicate whether all fibres are used by the Petitioner for its own use of data and voice communication or if some dark fibres (spare) are available, which may be leased or sold to third parties.
- iii. Is the cost of OPGW included in the actual Additional Capital Expenditure (ACE) claimed for the 2019-24 tariff period? If so, submit the financial year-wise details of revenue sharing for the 2019-24 tariff period in the following format:

In Petition No. 483/TT/2025

- i. The Commission vide order dated 1.10.2025 in Petition No. 360/TT/2023, addressed the issue of replacing ICT, invoked the 'Power to Remove Difficulty,' and proposed considering the book value of the spare ICT as the capital cost. In accordance with the directions of the Commission in the said order dated 1.10.2025, submit the reasons for not adopting the same methodology in this Petition.
 - ii. Details of the capital cost for the 2019-24 and 2024-29 tariff periods in accordance with the Commission's directions given in order dated 1.10.2025 in Petition No. 360/TT/2023.
3. The Commission further directed the Respondents to file their respective replies, if not already filed, within a week, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week thereafter.
