Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for the Respondent, SECI, in Petition No. 759/MP/2025, submitted that SECI has filed its reply in the matter. She also submitted that SECI has shared its respective replies with the Petitioners in Petition Nos. 933/MP/2025 and 952/MP/2025; however, these are yet to be filed/uploaded on the e-filing portal. Accordingly, she requested the opening of the e-filing portal for filing/uploading the replies in these matters.

2. Learned counsel for the Petitioners submitted that the pleadings are completed in Petition No. 759/MP/2025; however, SECI has delayed in filing its replies in the remaining Petitions.
