- Subject : Petition for the determination of tariff of the inter-State transmission lines connecting two states for APTRANSCO owned transmission lines for the 5th Control Period, i.e., FY 2024-25 to FY 2028-29 for inclusion in POC Mechanism in accordance with the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Sharing of Inter-State Transmission Charges and Losses) Regulations, 2020 and the Central Electricity Regulatory Commission (Terms and Conditions of Tariff) Regulations, 2024.

Record of Proceedings

The matter was heard through a virtual hearing.

2. During the hearing, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that the instant Petition has been filed for the determination of the transmission tariff for the inter-State transmission assets (40 Nos.) connecting two states for APTRANSCO-owned transmission lines for the 2024-29 tariff period for inclusion in POC Mechanism and sought liberty to file an amended Petition within four weeks incorporating the amended Tariff Forms in accordance with the Auditor's Certificate.
3. After hearing, the Commission directed as under:
 - a) Issue notice to the Respondent(s);
 - b) The Petitioner is directed to file an amended Petition incorporating the amended tariff forms along with the Auditor's Certificate, within four weeks, and thereafter, the Respondent(s) to file their respective replies, if any,

within two weeks, with a copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, within a week;

- c) SRLDC is directed to furnish the following information on an affidavit, within two weeks:
- i. Details regarding the installation of interface meters for the 40 transmission assets, along with clarification, as to whether such interface meters have been installed at both ends of the transmission assets;
 - ii. Drawal patterns recorded in the said interface meters for the purpose of energy treatment.
- d) Further, the Petitioner is directed to furnish the following information on an affidavit, within two weeks, with an advance copy to the Respondent(s):
- i. Single Line Diagram with respect to the transmission assets;
 - ii. Details of line-wise power flow of the transmission assets during the 2024-29 tariff period;
 - iii. Availability of the transmission lines for the 2024-29 tariff period, duly certified by the respective RLDCs;
 - iv. Justification for the construction of the transmission lines covered under Asset-36(b) & 37(b);
 - v. Detailed computation of the capital cost claimed with respect to Asset-36(b) & Asset-37(b), along with the Auditor's Certificate;
 - vi. Auditor's Certificate clearly indicating the Hard Cost, IDC and IEDC as well as element-wise capital cost (land, building, transmission line, sub-station, communication system) as on 31.03.2024.
 - vii. Applicable Tariff Forms in line with the Auditor's Certificates.
 - viii. Petitioner has claimed the applicable MAT Rate/ Effective Tax Rate for the 2024-29 tariff period. Accordingly, the Petitioner to submit supporting documents (Income Tax Returns/ Assessment Orders, if any, in sealed cover) for claiming the MAT Rate/ Effective Tax Rate.
 - ix. Calculation of the Weighted Average Rate of Interest (WAROI), in accordance with Form-9C.

4. The matter will be listed for further hearing on **14.5.2026**.
