**Record of Proceedings**

The matter was called out for a virtual hearing.

2. During the hearing, the representative(s) of the Petitioner submitted that the information has been filed in compliance with the RoP for the hearing dated 3.12.2025 and the TV letter dated 28.11.2025. Further, the Petitioner has filed the rejoinder to MSEDCL's reply and sought liberty to file a rejoinder to MPPMCL's reply.

3. The learned counsel for Respondent No. 1 (MPPMCL) submitted that the reply in the instant matter has been submitted vide affidavit dated 7.1.2026, and requested the Commission to consider the same while passing the tariff order. Learned counsel further made submissions on the issues of time overrun, cost overrun, ACE, delay in commissioning of Asset-2 due to RoW issues, downstream lines, and COD, etc.

4. The learned counsel for Respondent No. 2 (MSEDCL), submitted that the reply in the instant matter has been submitted vide affidavit dated 23.12.2025, and requested the Commission to consider the same while passing the tariff order. Further,

she made submissions regarding time overrun, cost overrun, IDC, IEDC, and GST, etc.

5. After hearing, the Commission directed all the Respondent(s) and the Petitioner to file their respective written submissions, if any, within a week, with a copy to each other.

6. Subject to the above, the Commission reserved the matter for order.
