All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jodhpur, Rajasthan, an apex healthcare institute established by an Act of Parliament of India under the aegis of the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, invites **item rate tender** in two bid system for **Shifting of the existing Rooftop Solar PV modules installed near STP to the Auditorium Parking at AIIMS, Jodhpur.**

1. **Bids shall be submitted online only at the CPP portal:**

<https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.

2. The complete bidding process is online. Bidders should have a valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of class II or III for online submission of bids. Before bidding, DSC needs to be registered on the website mentioned above. For any assistance with the e-bidding process, if required, a bidder may contact the helpdesk at 0291-2740741.

3. **Bidder/service provider is advised to follow the instructions provided in the ‘Instructions to the service providers/Bidders for the e-submission of the bids online through the Central Public Procurement Portal for e-Procurement at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>’. Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with a black and white option, which helps reduce the size of the scanned document.**

4. **Criteria of eligibility:**

The contractor who fulfills the following requirements shall be eligible to apply. Joint ventures are not accepted:

a. Should have satisfactorily completed similar works as mentioned below during the last seven years ending 28th February, 2026.

Note: Completion certificate must be attached. Failing which, the technical eligibility may not be considered for further tendering procedure.

“Similar works mean: Iron Fabrication Work or Installation of solar PV plant along with a shed.”

i. Three similar completed works, each of value not less than 40% of the estimated cost, put to tender

Or,

Two similar completed works, each of value not less than 60% of the estimated cost, are put to tender

Or

One similar completed work of value not less than 80% of the estimated cost is put to tender.

(Details should be mentioned in Annexure-II)

ii. The value of executed work shall be brought to the current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at a simple rate @ 7% per annum, calculated from the actual date of completion of work up to 28th February, 2026.

5. **Average Annual Financial Turnover:** Bidder should have an average Annual Financial Turnover of **₹. 45,00,000.00 (Rupees Forty-Five Lakh Only)** during the last three consecutive financial years ending 31st March 2025 (Scanned copy of Certificate from CA with Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) to be uploaded).

6. Earnest Money Deposit:

- a. The EMD amounting to ₹. 1,75,000.00 (Rs. One lakh Seventy-Five Thousand Only) shall be deposited in favor of “All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur”, in the form of FDR / BG of any Scheduled Bank, the same will be allowed with validity up to 180 days.
- b. The Hard Copy of the original instruments in respect of the earnest money deposit must be delivered to the AIIMS, Jodhpur, on or before the last date of submission of bid till 1500 hrs. The bid submitted without EMD will be summarily rejected.

7. Submission of Tender:

The tender shall be submitted online in two parts, viz., technical bid and financial bid. All the pages of a bid being submitted must be signed and sequentially numbered by the bidder, irrespective of the nature of the content of the documents, before uploading.

- ✓ **The offers submitted by email or any other media except the CPP portal shall not be considered. No correspondence will be entertained in this matter.**

8. Technical Bid

The following documents are to be furnished by the bidder along with the **Technical Bid** as per the tender document:

- A copy of the completion certificate from the client department/s.
- Original instrument for EMD
- A copy of a Valid electrical contractor license must be attached.
- A copy of PAN Card Registration.
- A copy of the GST registration certificate.
- Certificate as per Annexure I to VI

9. Financial Bid

Price bid Form - Price must be quoted as per the format specified; failing which, the tender shall be summarily rejected.

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Conditions of Contract

1. The rates shall be quoted only in the schedule of quantities i.e., BoQ, separately attached with the tender and nowhere else, i.e. letterheads, etc. The rates quoted should be inclusive of providing the material at the site, all related labour work, making good the area damaged/excavated during the work, all taxes, etc. Only GST shall be paid extra as applicable against the TAX invoices.
2. The contractor shall bear the cost of supplying the required material at the site, laying, termination of all the existing services being shifted, and making good to all the areas being damaged during the execution of the complete said work, etc. Nothing extra, other than the rates quoted, will be paid to the contractor in this regard.
3. The work of shifting existing 300kWP solar Modules, inverters, ACDB, and other accessories should be done through a specialized/expert agency, consisting of the specialized type of work, and the same is also covered under the RESCO model contract. The contractor shall get the agency approval from EIC before starting the shifting work. Only the approved agency shall be allowed to shift the solar. The work shall be done in full coordination with the existing vendor.
4. **Validity:** The quoted rates must be valid for **180 days** from the date of closing of the tender. The overall offer for the assignment and the bidder/s quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. If the bidder quoted a validity shorter than the required period, the same will be treated as unresponsive, and it may be rejected. In case the tenderer withdraws, modifies, or changes their offer during the validity period, the bid is liable to be rejected, and the bidders shall not be allowed to quote for any other tender of AIIMS- Jodhpur, and the same shall also be intimated to their respective parent department from where they are registered without assigning any reason thereof. The bidder should also be ready to extend the validity, if required, without changing any terms, conditions, etc. of their original tender. In case the last date of sale /, receipt of tender, / of opening the tender is declared as a Holiday, the respective dates shall be treated as postponed to the next working day accordingly.
5. **Technical Evaluation:**
 - a. The detailed technical evaluation shall be carried out by the Institute under conditions in the tender document to determine the substantial responsiveness of each tender. For this clause, the substantially responsive bid conforms to all the eligibility and terms and conditions of the tender without any deviation.
 - b. The Institute's determination of the bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. The Institute shall evaluate the technical bids also to determine whether they are complete, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the bids are in order. The Executive Director, AIIMS, Jodhpur shall have the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons thereof.
 - c. Conditional bids will be treated as unresponsive and will be rejected.
6. **Financial Evaluation:**

The financial bid shall be opened to only those bidders who are technically eligible. After the evaluation of the bid(s), AIIMS-Jodhpur will award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder on a **composite basis**
7. The right to issue and to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof is reserved by the Competent Authority, AIIMS-Jodhpur.

- 8. Award of Contract:** The Institute shall consider placement of orders for jobs on those bidders whose offers have been found technical and financially acceptable.
- 9. Performance bank guarantee:**
- Performance guarantee of the contract by all the terms and conditions specified in the tender, the successful tenderer/contractor shall furnish a Performance bank guarantee @7.5% of order value in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee (as per attached format) from any Nationalized Bank duly pledged in the name of the "All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur" after receipt of supply order.
 - AIIMS-Jodhpur shall have the right to encash the PBG for non-compliance with any or all the terms and conditions of the tender/contract and to recover any Liquid Damages and penalties under the contract, as well as against defects in any of the work as enumerated in the tender/contract.
 - Refund of PBG-** Release of the Performance bank guarantee of the work shall be refunded after 12 months of completion of work & issuance of the completion certificate by the Engineer-In-Charge.
- 10. Authority of person signing document:** A person signing the tender form or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warrant, that he has authority to bind such other and if, on inquiry, it appears that the person so, signing had no authority to do so, the Executive Director, AIIMS, Jodhpur may without prejudice to other Civil and criminal remedies cancel the contract and held the signatory liable for all cost and damages.
- 11. Right of acceptance:** The institute reserves the right to accept the whole or any part or portion of the bid, and the bidder shall provide the same at the rates quoted. The Institute reserves the right to reject any or all tenders /quotations or all offers received in response to the tender or cancel or withdraw the tender notice without assigning any reason thereof, and also does not bind itself to accept the lowest quotation or any tender, and no claim in this regard shall be entertained.
- 12. Liquidated Damage:** - *If the contractor / Supplier fails to finish the work within the stipulated time frame mentioned in the work order, then a penalty @ 1% per week of the total order value shall be levied, subject to a maximum of 10% of the total order value.*
- 13. Subletting of Work:** The firm shall not assign or sublet the whole tender to any other person/party without prior intimation to the institute. The tender is not transferable. Only one tender shall be submitted by one bidder.
- 14. Breach of Terms and Conditions:** In case of breach of any terms and conditions as mentioned in the tender, the Competent Authority will have the right to reject the bid at any stage without assigning any reason thereof, and nothing will be payable by AIIMS, Jodhpur in that event, the PG shall also stand forfeited.
- 15. Applicable Law:**
- The contractor shall supply the material and execute the work according to the relevant /Electricity Act, 2003/National Action Plan on Climate Change (NAPCC)/National Solar Mission/Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE)/CPWD/BIS, etc. norms
 - The contract shall be governed by laws and procedures established by the Government of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactments made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/ processing.
 - The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliations

Act, 1996, and the venue of arbitration shall be at Jodhpur. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both parties. Any disputes are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the competent court and forum in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India, only.

16. Force Majeure: Any delay due to Force Majeure will not be attributable to the service provider.
17. **Payment shall be made only after completion of work on the actual measurement and testing of work done at the site.**
18. ***The quantities are approximate and may increase or decrease as per the actual requirement of work. The contractor shall do the work of the additional quantity upto 1.5 times of contract value AND / OR reduced quantity on the rates quoted in the tender documents. The payment shall be made based on the actual quantity executed at the site. The contractor shall have no claim to any payment or compensation whatsoever on account of any profit advantage or loss which might have been derived from the work, and the actual / ordered / indented quantity.***
19. The contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to the AIIMS- Jodhpur property or allottee's property by him or his labor in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost.
20. In case of any discrimination, the decision of the Executive Director, AIIMS- Jodhpur shall be final and binding on the bidder/contractor.

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Scope of Work

1. The work includes **design, fabrication, supply, installation, testing, and commissioning of a new parking shed**, along with **dismantling, shifting, reinstallation, and commissioning of the existing solar photovoltaic (PV) system** from the existing parking shed to the newly constructed parking shed.
2. The contractor shall be responsible for the **complete structural design** of the parking shed in accordance with relevant Indian Standards, considering wind load, seismic load, dead load, live load, solar PV load, etc.
3. The contractor shall prepare **detailed Good for Construction (GFC) drawings and structural design calculations**, which any IIT/NIT shall vet, and all associated costs shall be borne by the contractor.
4. The scope includes **fabrication, supply, and erection** of the parking shed structure comprising columns, beams, trusses, roofing sheets, and all associated fittings and fixtures, including necessary **civil works such as foundations**.
5. The parking shed shall be designed and constructed with **adequate provisions for mounting of solar PV panels**, ensuring structural safety and proper alignment.
6. The contractor shall carry out **careful dismantling of the existing solar PV system**, including solar modules, inverters, mounting structures, cables, conduits, earthing system, and all associated accessories.
7. Proper **labeling, documentation, and inventory** of dismantled components shall be maintained during dismantling and shifting.
8. The contractor shall ensure **safe handling, packing, transportation, and shifting** of all solar PV components to the new parking shed location.
9. The contractor shall carry out the **reinstallation of the solar PV system** on the new parking shed, ensuring proper tilt, orientation, and alignment of modules for optimum performance.
10. The scope includes **reconnection of all electrical systems**, including DC and AC cabling, inverters, earthing, and protection systems.
11. The contractor shall perform **testing and commissioning** of the complete solar PV system to ensure satisfactory and efficient operation as per standard Indian government norms.
12. The contractor shall be **fully responsible for safety and protection of all solar PV components**, and any damage during dismantling, shifting, or reinstallation shall be **repaired or replaced at no extra cost**.
13. The contractor shall ensure the **complete safety of personnel, materials, and existing infrastructure** during execution of the work.
14. The bidder must **visit the site** before submission of the bid to understand site conditions, existing installations, and the scope of work. No claim due to lack of site knowledge shall be entertained after issuance of the work order/starting of work.
15. All works shall conform to **relevant Indian Standards, electrical regulations, and safety norms**, and necessary approvals shall be obtained by the contractor.
16. Upon completion, the contractor shall ensure **successful commissioning and handover** of the parking shed and solar PV system in fully operational condition, along with submission of all relevant drawings and documents.
