Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the learned counsel for the Respondent, CTUIL, submitted that the Detailed Procedure envisaged under Regulation 11A(6)(c) of the GNA Regulations has been published on 10.4.2026 and consequently, the present Petition has lost its foundation. The learned counsel also submitted that the Petitioner may instead approach CTUIL directly by way of an application seeking appropriate relief.

2. In response, the learned counsel for the Petitioners submitted that the Petitioners have already spent around six months pursuing this Petition and as their case is squarely covered by the Detailed Procedure now issued by CTUIL under Regulation 11A(6)(c), the Commission may consider passing an appropriate order in the matter. Alternatively, the Commission may permit the Petitioners to file an application before CTUIL in terms of the Detailed Procedure, with a direction to CTUIL to take necessary action on such application within a period of thirty days.

3. The learned counsel for the Respondent, CTUIL, however, pointed out that the Detailed Procedure already prescribes the timeline of 60 days for processing an application submitted before it.

4. Considering the submissions made by the learned counsels for the parties, the Commission reserved the order in the matter.
