Record of Proceedings

At the outset, the learned counsel for the Petitioner submitted that, *vide* the Record of Proceedings dated 26.2.2026, the notice was issued to the Respondents, allowing them to file their replies, if any. However, none of the Respondents has filed any reply in the matter.

2. The learned counsel for the Respondent, ACME Solar Holdings Limited, while supporting the Petition, submitted that the Respondent has already entered into a Power Purchase Agreement with the Petitioner for the capacity allotted under the Greenhoe Option, i.e., 250 MW.
