GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE GUIDANCE OF CONTRACTOR

Sealed Tenders are invited from valid MNRE empanelled brands/ Suppliers / System integrator) by Rural development and self employment training institute(RUDSETI),ujire, hereinafter known as the Employer and also as RUDSETI CS, for the Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning and Maintenance of 83 KWp Capacity ON-Grid Rooftop Solar Power System in above mentioned locations in Karnataka state.

Scope of work covers for Supply, Installation, Testing, Commissioning & Maintenance of 83 KWp Capacity ON-Grid Rooftop Solar Power System, with annual maintenance contract for 4 years after defect liability period of one year.(pls note, if the warranty specified by the manufacturers is more than the warranty mentioned in the tender, the same shall be passed on to our institutes.)

The Contractor has to take all permits, No Objection Certificates (NOC), approvals and other liaison works with all concerned statutory and Non-statutory agencies like all Discoms/EBs in Karnataka, respective city/town municipal office, etc. No deviation shall be accepted under any circumstance. The comprehensive maintenance shall include preventive maintenance service visits quarterly and

replacements of all defective components /panels at no cost till the completion of warranty period/AMC period as given by the manufacturer and the supplier. The maintenance shall include replacement of all parts or components found defective due to manufacturing defect or because of wear and tear. If the SPV Power Plants are not functional, the same should be repaired or restored or replaced within 2 days.

2. Tender documents consisting of specifications, schedule of quantities of the various items of work to be done and the set of terms and conditions of contract to be complied with by the contractor whose tender may be accepted and other necessary documents will be sent through registered post.

3. The tender concept is "**TWO BID SYSTEM**". It should be always be placed in sealed cover, with the name of the project written on the envelope mentioning "Technical Bid on the cover containing technical details and Price Bid on the cover containing financial bid" on the prescribed date and time mentioned in the Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) to **The** Executive Director, Rudseti central secretariat, Ujire . Dakshin kannada district , Karnataka state - 574240

3.1. The envelope super-scribed as "Technical & Price Bid of **"SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, TESTING, COMMISSIONING & MAINTENANCE OF 83KWp as PER SITE CAPACITY ON-GRID ROOF TOP SOLAR PV POWER PLANT"** should be submitted in a sealed envelope containing all the following details:

i). All the schedules of the tender document, tender drawings if any & technical & Price details of the proposed system equipment with its components & all other attachments including Bill of Quantity (Price Bid).

ii). The tender) shall be accompanied by earnest money of **Rs. 66000 (Rupees sixty six thousand only)** by way of Demand Draft issued in favour of "Canara Rudseti CS" payable at Ujire, karnataka or However, those who have exemption certificate from NSIC/Similar Government authorities as per provision of MSME Act will be exempted from submission of EMD subject to the submission of valid document/certificate to that effect. (EMD should in separate envelope)

No interest shall be allowed on the Earnest Money. Tenders without Earnest Money/BG shall be rejected.

4. PRE BID QUERIES AND CLARIFICATION TO THE TENDER:

4.1 The Vendor should carefully examine and understand the specifications, terms and conditions of the Tender and may seek clarifications, if required. The Vendor in all such cases seek clarification in writing in a word document (.doc) in the same serial order of that of the Tender by mentioning the relevant page number and clause number of the Tender. All communications regarding points requiring clarifications and any doubts shall be sent by E-mail id to rudseti@rediffmail.com **on or before 25/04/2026 2 pm**. No oral or individual consultation shall be entertained. No queries will be entertained from the Vendors after the pre-bid meeting.

4.2 Pre-Bid meeting:

We will also share the link for those who cannot come to ujire and wish to participate through Video conference . They can attend from our RUDSETI Premises at Arishinakunte, Nelamangala, Bengaluru. Those who want to participate through VC, have to confirm through email, there upon VC link will be shared.

No separate communication will be sent for this meeting. If the meeting date is declared as a holiday under NI Act by the Government subsequent to issuance of RFP, the next working day will be deemed to be the pre-bid meeting day. Authorized representatives of interested Vendors shall be present during the scheduled time.

The Rudseti CS will consolidate all the queries and discussions during the pre-bid meeting and the consolidated replies for the queries shall be made available in the Rudseti CS's website/Canara Bank Website and no individual correspondence shall be made. The replies/clarification of the Rudseti CS in response to the queries raised by the bidder/s, and any other clarification / amendments / corrigendum furnished hereof will become part and parcel of the Tender document and it will be binding on the Vendors.

Non-reply to the queries raised by any of the Vendor shall not be accepted as a valid reason for non-submission of the Tender. In addition, non-reply to any query may not be deemed the version of the Vendor as reflected in the query has been accepted by the Rudseti CS.

6.3 Amendment to Tender Document:

At any time prior to deadline for submission of Tender, the Rudseti CS, for any reason, whether, at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by prospective bidder may modify the Tender document by amendment.

In order to allow prospective Vendors reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their tender, the Rudseti CS, at its discretion, may extend the deadline for a reasonable period as decided by the Rudseti CS for the submission of tender.

5. OFFER VALIDITY PERIOD:

The Offer submitted and the Price quoted therein shall be valid for 120 days from the date of opening of tender document i.e. Technical bid and for such further period as may be requested for by the Rudseti CS, and agreed to in writing by the bidder.

6. The time allowed for carrying out of the work will be not exceeding the period specified in the NIT.

7. The contractors should quote in figures as well as in words the rate, and amount tendered by them. The amount for each item should be worked out and the requisite totals given. The rates

quoted shall be all inclusive rates for the item of work described, including materials, labour, tools & plant, carriage & transport, supervision, overheads & profits, mobilising and other charges whatsoever including any anticipated or un-anticipated difficulties etc. complete for proper execution of the work as per drawings and specifications and no claim whatsoever for any extra payment shall be maintainable.

8. The rates quoted by the Contractors shall be inclusive of obtaining No Objection Certificates (NOC) and other liaison works with all concerned statutory and Non-statutory agencies like BESCOM/MESCOM/CHESCOM/GESCOM etc, TOWN /CITY MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS & Other Central & State government agencies. etc

9. When a contractor signs a tender in an Indian language, the percentage above or below and the tendered amount and the total amount tendered should also be written in the same language. In the case of illiterate contractors the rates or the amounts tendered should be attested by a witness.

10. Issue of tender form / documents is as per the NIT.

11. The acceptance of a tender will rest with the Employer which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender, and reserves to itself the authority to reject any or all of the tenders received without assigning any reason. All tenders in which any of the prescribed conditions are not fulfilled or are incomplete in any respect are liable to be rejected.

12. THE EMPLOYER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO ACCEPT THE TENDER IN FULL OR IN PART AND THE CONTRACTOR SHALL HAVE NO CLAIM FOR REVISION OF RATES/OTHER CONDITIONS IF HIS TENDER IS ACCEPTED IN PART.

13. Canvassing in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.

14. All rates shall be quoted on the proper form of the tender alone. Quoted rates and units different from prescribed in the tender schedule will be liable for rejection.

14.1 Special care should be taken to write the rates in figures as well as in words and the amounts in figures only, in such a way that interpolation is not possible. The total amount should be written both in figures and in words. In case of figures, the words 'Rs.' should be written before the figure of rupees and words 'P' after the decimal figures, e.g. Rs.2.15 "P" and in case of words, the word 'Rupees' should precede and the word 'Paise' should be written at the end, unless the rate is in whole rupees and followed by the words 'only' it should be invariably be up to two decimal places. While quoting the rate is in schedule of quantities, the word 'only' should be written closely following the amount and it should not be written in the next line. However, if a discrepancy is found;

i). the rates which correspond with the amount worked out by the Contractor shall unless otherwise proved be taken as correct. (OR)

ii). if the amount of an item is not worked out by the Contractor or it does not correspond with the rates written either in figures or in words then the rate quoted by the Contractor in words shall be taken as correct. (OR)

iii). where the rates quoted by the Contractor in figures and in words tally but the amount is not worked out correctly, the rates quoted by the Contractor will unless otherwise prove be taken as correct and not the amount.

14.2 In the case of any errors or omissions in the quoted rates, and if the tender is issued in duplicate, the rates quoted in the tender marked "Original" shall be taken as correct rates.

14.3 All corrections such as cuttings, interpolations, omissions and over-writings shall be number as 'c', 'i', 'o' and 'ow' and initialed and total of such c, i, o and ow on each page certified at the end of the page with grand total at the end of the bill/schedule of quantities.

15. An item rate tender containing percentage below / above will be summarily rejected. However, where a Contractor voluntarily offers a rebate for payment within a stipulated period, this may be considered.

16. Goods & Service Tax (GST) is payable extra by Rudseti CS. Sales tax, service tax, work contract tax, or any other tax, any royalties, import duty, other duties if any, levies, cess, entry tax, Octroi, profession tax, Sales Tax, purchase tax, turnover tax, or any other tax on material or finished work in respect of this contract shall be payable by the Contractor and the Employer will not entertain any claim whatsoever in respect of the same, and nothing extra shall be paid/reimbursed for the same subsequently **with exception specified in the clause 8 of the General Conditions of the contract of this tender.**

17. The contractor shall give a list of his relatives, if any, working with the Employer along with their designations and addresses.

18. No employee of the employer is allowed to work as a contractor for a period of 2 years of his/her retirement from the employer services, without the previous permission of the employer. This contract is liable to be cancelled if either the contractor or any of his employees is found at any time to be such a person who had not obtained the permission of the employer as aforesaid before submission of the tender or engagement in the contractor's service.

19. The tender for the works shall remain open for acceptance for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of tenders. If any Contractor withdraws his tender before the said period or makes any modifications in the terms and conditions of the tender which are not acceptable to the

Employer, then the Employer shall, without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit full value of the earnest money as aforesaid.

20. The tender for the work shall not be witnessed by a contractor or contractors who himself / themselves has / have tendered or who may and had/have tendered for the same work. Failure to observe this condition would render tenders of the contractors tendering as well as witnessing the tender liable to summary rejection.

21. It will be obligatory on the part of the Contractor to tender and sign the tendered documents for all the component parts and that, after the work is awarded, he / they will have to enter into an agreement for each component with the competent authority of the Employer.

22. Further the Contractor shall agree that until a formal agreement is executed and signed, this tender shall constitute a binding contract between the Contractor and the Employer. The stamp paper of requisite value as per State Governments should be borne by the Contractor.

23. The Contractor, apart from being a competent contractor must associate himself with agencies of appropriate class who are eligible to tender for other related works connected directly or indirectly with the contract and employed by the employer.

23.1. The Employer does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves to itself the right of accepting the whole or any part of the tender and the Contractor shall be bound to perform the same at the rate quoted.

23.2 Contractor are advised to inspect and examine the site and its surroundings and satisfy themselves before submitting their tenders as to the nature of the site and dimensions, the means of access to the site, and obtain all necessary information as to risks, contingencies and other circumstances which may influence or affect their tender.

23.3 A Contractor shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site whether he inspects it or not and no extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding or otherwise shall be allowed. Submission of a tender by a Contractor implies that he has read this notice and all other contract documents and has made himself aware of the scope and specifications of the work to be done and local conditions and other factors bearing on the execution of the work.

24. On acceptance of the tender, the name of the accredited representative(s) of the contractor who would be responsible for taking instructions from the Employer shall be communicated to the Employer.

25. Method of Evaluation of tender: All the competitive tenders will be received on the specified date and time. On the same day or on specified date & time in event of any compelling circumstances, the tender will be opened in the presence of the available Contractor.

25.1 The "Technical Bid" will be opened and details of EMD etc., shall be recorded. Incomplete offers and offers not accompanied by the mandatory documents and EMD shall be rejected.

25.2 Voluntary submission of the supplementary Price bid by the contractor/ Contractor shall not be accepted and supplementary bids shall be limited to the details sought for by the Employer only. Any other un-related Price variations furnished in supplementary Price bids shall not be recognized and might be liable for rejections if undue information are furnished.

25.3 In case of other un-successful Contractors, the EMD shall be returned treating it individually after finalizing the L1 vendor.

The Employer reserves the right to accept or reject any of the offer's without assigning any reason and no dispute or negotiation will be entertained in this regard. The Employer's decision will be final in the matter.

25.4 Techno Economic evaluations:

Being a techno - economical project, besides the capital cost, the present value of Comprehensive AMC charges for 4 years after completion of defect liability period will also be evaluated. The present value of the AMC component per year will be calculated as per the following formula:

$$\text{Present Value} = c/(1+r)^n$$

Where 'c' is the annual AMC of each year

'r' is REPO LINKED Lending Rate(RLLR) which is at present 5.25%

'n' is number of years, ie., n is 1 for 1st year and 2 for 2nd year...

The above mentioned calculation is for Price comparison purpose only.

Therefore, the Contractors / contractors shall furnish the AMC charges in the Price bid for years and terms of AMC shall be furnished in the technical bid clearly furnishing the details regarding the scope of AMC, details of spares, consumables & equipments covered and also details of exclusions.

25.5 In case of quoting for very low abnormal AMC rates, Rudseti CS reserves the right to seek for the Performance Guarantee to the extent of 10% of the project cost throughout the 5 year period (1year Defect Liability period and 4 years under CMC)

26. The minimum annual generation guarantee of solar power should be as per the clause 19 of "General conditions of the Contract".

27. The successful Contractor/contractor, on acceptance of his tender by the Accepting Authority, shall, within 14 days from the stipulated date of start of the work sign on a stamp paper the contract consisting of :-

(a) Standard form of Agreement & Indemnity Bond on stamp paper.
